- Clinical hospital privileges;
- DEA and CDS registration (as applicable);
- Board certification;
- Medical school and residency;
- Malpractice insurance coverage and claims history;
- Medicare/Medicaid sanctions;
- State license sanctions query;
- Work history; and
- NPDB query

“At the heart of InRoomMD's Travel Healthcare Concierge model is quality assurance for individuals that cannot access their usual medical provider from their travel destination,” said InRoomMD National Medical Director Carl A. Smart, MD. “Credentialing Corporation of America is a highly qualified, certified credentialing provider that ensures InRoomMD fulfills its quality guarantee.”
